

FISHING REGULATIONS

DURING THE DAY



As a guest staying at De Schatberg, you can fish extensively in the lakes with a Schatberg fishing permit. Because other activities also take place on the lakes, there are some agreements:

- 1.** Fishing is allowed from 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM (including setup and packing).
- 2.** Night fishing is allowed. The regulations for this can be found on the following page.
- 3.** For the breeding pond and the connecting channel to the main lake, fishing is not allowed. This is to avoid disrupting the spawning area.
- 4.** During fishing, the fishing permit, in combination with the park pass, must always be presented upon request by inspectors, staff, or management of De Schatberg, and instructions should be followed.
- 5.** Keep your fishing spot clean and take everything back with you. (Full in, empty out should be possible.)
- 6.** It is not allowed to consume alcohol or other beverages in glass containers around the lakes.
- 7.** It is not allowed to park motorised vehicles such as cars, trailers, golf carts, quads, trikes and scooters at the lakes.
- 8.** Fishing with white maggots is allowed. Coloured (red) maggots are prohibited. Due to the risk of water acidification, feeding should be minimized: a maximum of 2 kilograms for carp anglers and a maximum of 500 grams for whitefish anglers.
- 9.** Fishing with two fishing rods is allowed. The angler must be present with the rods. Leaving to get coffee or similar activities means retrieving the lines.
- 10.** With the fixed fishing rod, fishing is allowed everywhere except along the water ski area during operating hours.
- 11.** Only a pike or zander that meets the size requirements may be taken. All other fish species should be handled with care and released as quickly as possible.
- 12.** Keepnets, traps, cross nets, and drift nets are not allowed at the fishing spot.
- 13.** Unhooking mats are recommended and mandatory for carp fishing.
- 14.** The use of bait boats, rubber boats, remote-controlled boats, etc., along and on the fishing water is not allowed (unless indicated otherwise, see the next page).
- 15.** Fishing without a permit will result in a fine of €20,00. Repeat offenses will lead to a complete fishing ban and possible further measures by the management of De Schatberg.
- 16.** Day passes for visitors are available at the reception. These day passes should be obtained by guests staying at the park and not by the visitors themselves. The guest should bring a park pass and must be present with the visitor while fishing. The cost for a day pass is €3,00.

FISHING REGULATIONS DURING THE NIGHT



Night fishing is allowed from 6:00 PM until the next morning at 10:00 AM. Setting up and dismantling the carp tent, as well as leaving the fishing spot clean, are included in this period. In case of scheduled fishing competitions, there will be indications of the time by which the spots need to be vacated.

Night fishing is allowed throughout the year on the specified days, under the following conditions:

- Boilie bait boats are allowed on the main lake on the side of the roadway.
- Forward navigation is permitted exclusively.
- Navigating in a V-shape that obstructs others' fishing opportunities is not allowed.

Small lake:

- Monday evening to Tuesday morning.
 - Friday evening to Saturday morning.
- The use of a boilie bait boat is **NOT** allowed on this pond.

Large lake:

- Monday evening to Tuesday morning.
- Wednesday evening to Thursday morning.
- Friday evening to Saturday morning.



ATTENTION!

When the water ski course is in operation, indicated by the flag, it is not allowed to cast along the trajectory of the water ski course. However, this is allowed during night fishing. The use of bait and/or boilie boats on the course is also permitted at night.
